Officers responded to 523 Flint Avenue in reference to a subject being attacked by several dogs. When Officers arrived they located two subjects that had indeed been bitten. One victim had several serious bite wounds and the other victim had minor injuries. Both victims were transported to High Point Regional Hospital where they received treatment for their injuries.

The investigation revealed that the two dogs, both of mixed breeds, were "joined" together and the owners attempted to separate them. The dogs became irritated when separated and attacked the owners. Jennifer Murphy Baldwin, W/F/39 received several serious bite and puncture wounds and Thomas Howard Roy Jr. W/M/24 received several puncture wounds. At last check both victims were still at the hospital. No other subjects were attacked.

The two dogs involved in the attack were seized by Animal Control Officers and taken to the Guilford County Animal Shelter. This incident is under investigation to see if any criminal acts had occurred.
