

Special Order by Consent (SOC)

What is an SOC?

The Special Order by Consent is an agreement with the State whereby the City has committed to make improvements in its sanitary sewer infrastructure within a specified time period.

Our wastewater flow amounts are under restriction for both the Eastside and Westside Plants until certain improvements are made in our sanitary sewer outfall system. Additional flow amounts are 0.5 mgd for Eastside and 0.2 mgd for Westside currently.

What's the plan?

Eastside

- Deep River Outfall Segment 3 by Summer 2007
(frees up flow restrictions on the Eastside Plant)
- Deep River Outfall Segments 5 & 6 by Spring 2009

Westside

- Kool Pool Outfall Section 1 by Summer 2007
(get additional flow allowance of 0.2 mgd)
- Kool Pool Outfall Section 2 by Winter 2007
(get additional flow allowance of 0.2 mgd)
- Kindergarden Outfall Sections 1B & 1C by Spring 2008
- Corbett Outfall Section A & B by Winter 2008
(get additional flow allowance of 0.2 mgd)
- Kindergarden Outfall Section 1A by Spring 2009

End of SOC – Summer of 2009, 90 days after the completion of outfalls.
